Ectoparasite (tick) control: Spray/Dip:
Supatraz 25% OR MaxiCyp.

Dewormers: Lambs: Endo + Lint (6 – 8 weeks and 10 – 12 weeks of age), Adults: See diagram.

Vaccinations: Ovi-Clos P: Lambs at 2 months & 3 months of age. Ewes/Rams annually.

Vitamins + Minerals: Complex A&E for Sheep and goats (before lambing & breeding); B-co Bolic (for sick animals), and Complex Forte (in winter).

Nutritional supplements: Eze-Graze (May to Oct).

Broad-spectrum antibiotic: Maxitet LA & Maxi-Trim.

Wound Spray: SupaSpray Plus.

EMERGENCY TREATMENT FOR ANAEMIA ("BLOOD LOSS") DUE TO ROUNDWORMS

DAY 1:

Dose Levamisole or Endo + Lint AND Complex Forte.

Day 7 - 10:

Dose Ovi-dose 4 or Moxidazole.



Ideal -
No Dose

Evaluate the degree of Anaemia by looking at the colour of the mucous membranes of the eye.

Critical - Dose

This is an example of a sheep / goat with pale mucous membranes that require emergency treatment.
