## INDICATIONS

READY-TO-USE OILY SOLUTION INJECTABLE VITAMIN FOR CATTLE AND PIGS FOR THE TREATMENT OF AVITAMINOSIS A, D AND E AS A SUPPLEMENTARY THERAPY, ESPECIALLY IN THE FOLLOWING CASES:

- Antimicrobial and antiparasitic treatments.
- Convalescence, pregnancy, delivery.
- Stress.
- Pasture fed cattle during drought periods.

## COMPOSITION

Every 1 ml contains:

<b>Vitamin A palmitate</b>	<b>500 000 IU</b>
<b>Vitamin D3</b>	<b>75 000 IU</b>
<b>Vitamin E acetate</b>	<b>50 IU</b>

## STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS

Store in a cool dark place away from direct sunlight between 5 °C and 25 °C.

## WARNINGS

- Keep out of reach of children, uninformed persons and animals.
- Although this remedy has been extensively tested under a large variety of conditions, failure thereof may ensue as a result of a wide range of reasons. If this is suspected, seek veterinary advice and notify the registration holder.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE: USE ONLY AS DIRECTED

- SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE.
- Method of administration: subcutaneous or intramuscular injection.

## CATTLE

Administer intramuscularly or subcutaneously every 3 months. Under intensive farming conditions, the Vitamin A needs may be much higher, but consult an animal health nutritionist or veterinarian before dosages are increased.

Dosing guide for cattle	
	Dose (ml)
Adults	2 ml / animal (500 kg)
Breeding animals	0,5 ml / 125 kg
Yearlings	1 ml / animal (250 kg)
Weaners	0,5 ml / animal (125 kg)

## PIGS

Administer intramuscularly or subcutaneously every 12 months.

Dosing guide for pigs	Dose (ml / kg)
Adults	1 ml / 100 kg
Breeding animals	0,5 ml / 100 kg
Young animals	2 ml / 100 kg



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
